Goal 6 - Doubles

Add: 3+3, 4+4, 6+6, 7+7, 8+8, 9+9

Sub: 6-3, 8-4, 12-6, 14-7, 16-8, 18-9

- Concentration (from https://www.quia.com/cc/325021.html) Two or more people can play, "Concentration." The object of the game is to find pairs of matching cards among an array of face down cards. Help your child write addition or subtraction facts (e.g., 6 + 6 or 14-7) on one set of index cards and the answers (e.g. 12 or 7) on another set. Use a limited number of cards to start with, maybe 8 pairs, and slowly increase the number when your child seems ready for more.
 - Shuffle the cards and lay them out face down. The first player turns over two cardss, if they match (i.e., 6+6 and 12), the player keeps the two cards and takes another turn. If the two cards are different (i.e., 6+6 and 8), the cards must be placed back in their same positions face down. The next player takes a turn trying to find two matching cards. As the game progresses, players must concentrate and try to remember where the different numbered cards are located. When all the cards have been collected, the person with the most pairs wins.
